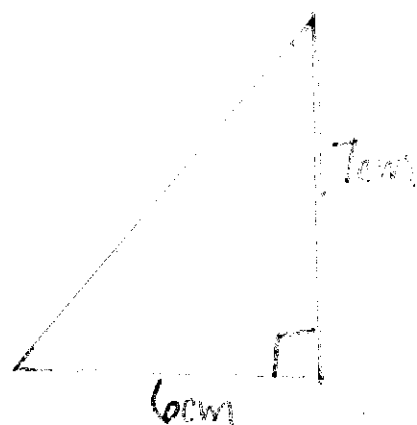


Finding Area of Triangles

Formula = $\frac{1}{2}bh$

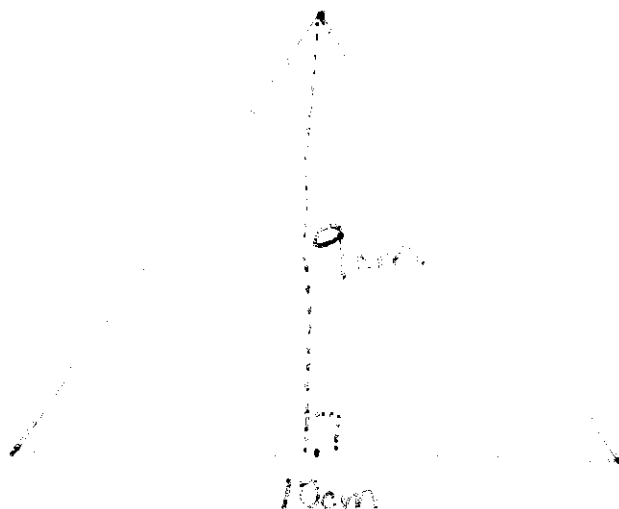
b = base length
h = height



$$A = \frac{1}{2} \cdot 6 \cdot 7$$

$$A = \frac{1}{2} 42$$

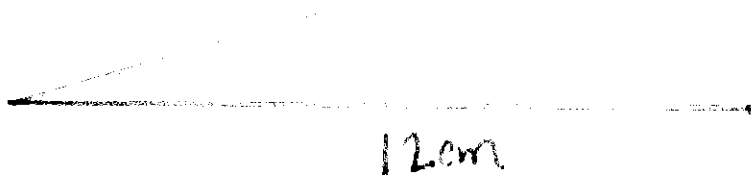
$$A = 21\text{cm}^2$$



$$A = \frac{1}{2} \cdot 10 \cdot 7$$

$$A = \frac{1}{2} 70$$

$$A = 35\text{cm}^2$$



$$A = \frac{1}{2} \cdot 12 \cdot 5$$

$$A = \frac{1}{2} 60$$

$$A = 30\text{cm}^2$$

the units when
finding area.
